God Created You and Loves You

"In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." - Genesis 1:1

Jesus said, "I came that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly." - John 10:10

Our Sin Separates Us from God

Sin is anything we think, say, or do that goes against God, who is perfect. All people (including me and you) are sinners. We deserve eternal separation from God in Hell because of our sin.

God Sent Jesus to Save Us

Jesus is the Only Way to God
